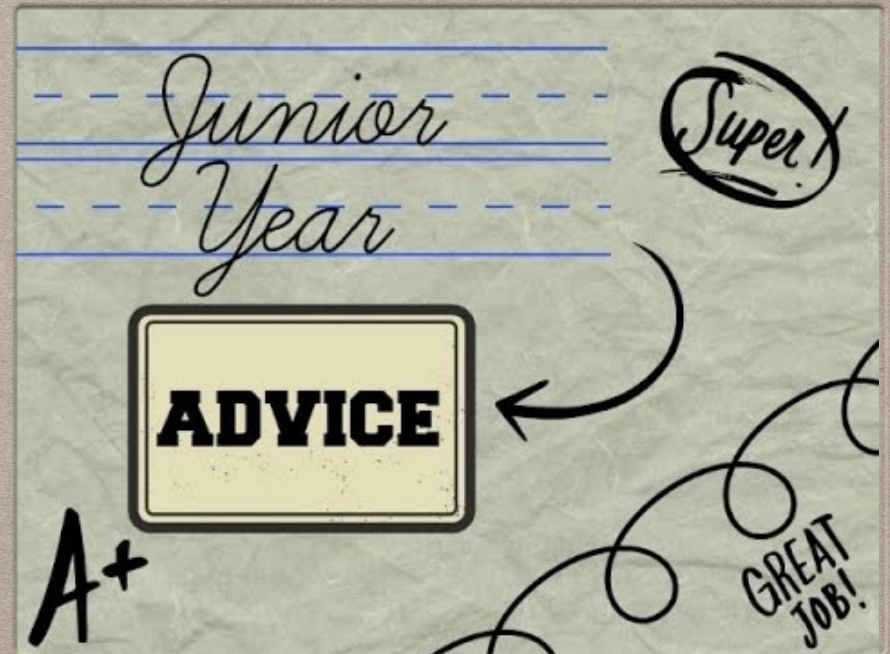
# 10TH GRADE

- *Throughout the year focus on:*

  - Career and post-secondary research
- **September:**
  - Back-to-school night (S1)
  - Club Drive
- **October:**
  - Career Day/ Graduation project task
- **September:**
  - CTC visits for 1/2 day programs
- **February:**
  - Back to school night (S2)
- **March:**
  - Course selection



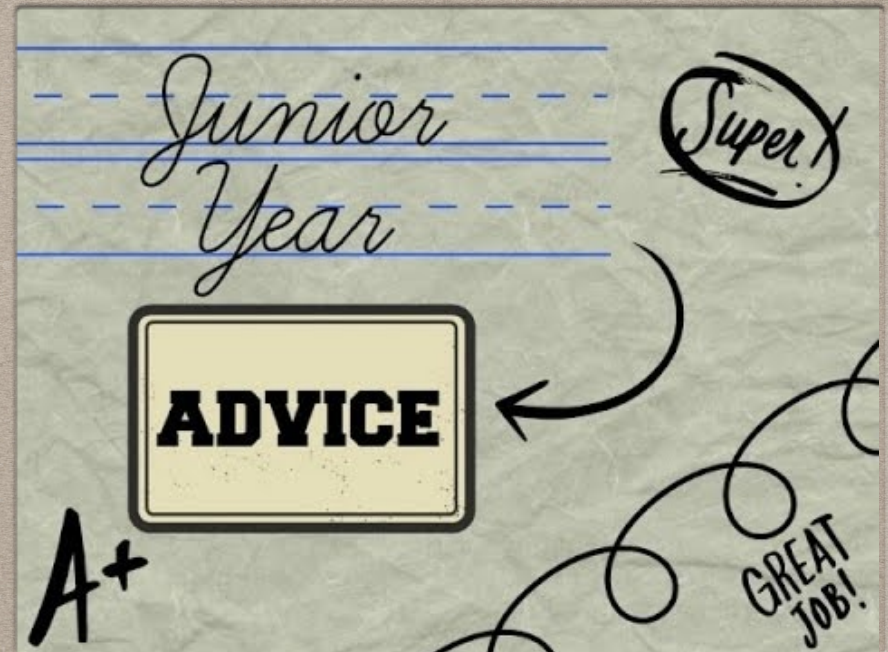
# 11TH GRADE

- **September:**
  - Back to school night (S1)
  - Sign-ups for college reps visitation (throughout the fall - sign up in Naviance)
- **October:**
  - Academy Night (Military)
  - PSAT's (10/19/16)
  - CTC assembly and sign-ups for tours for full day programs
- **November:**
  - College Night (CV High School)
  - Register for January SAT
  - CTC Visits
- **December:**
  - Look for PSAT score reports



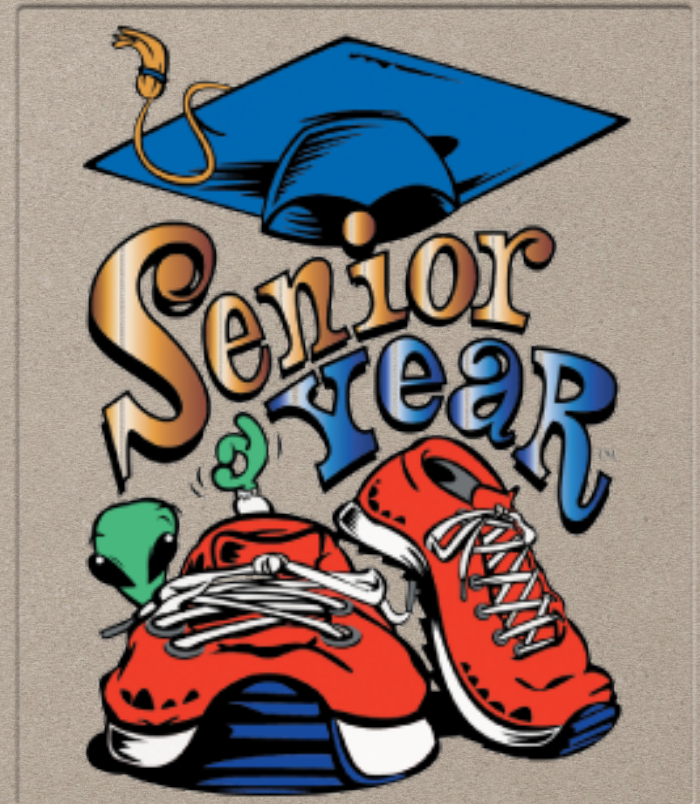
# 11TH GRADE

- **January:**
  - Start post-secondary search (Naviance)
  - CTC applications due
- **February:**
  - NCAA clearinghouse registration
  - ASVAB sign-ups (Military)
  - Back to school night (S2)
- **March:**
  - Course selection (check to ensure you are meeting college requirements)
  - Sign-up for AP exams
- **April:**
  - Do a few college visits and/or career shadowing experiences
- **May:**
  - Make sure your 11th grade Graduation Project tasks are complete!
  - Sign up for June SAT



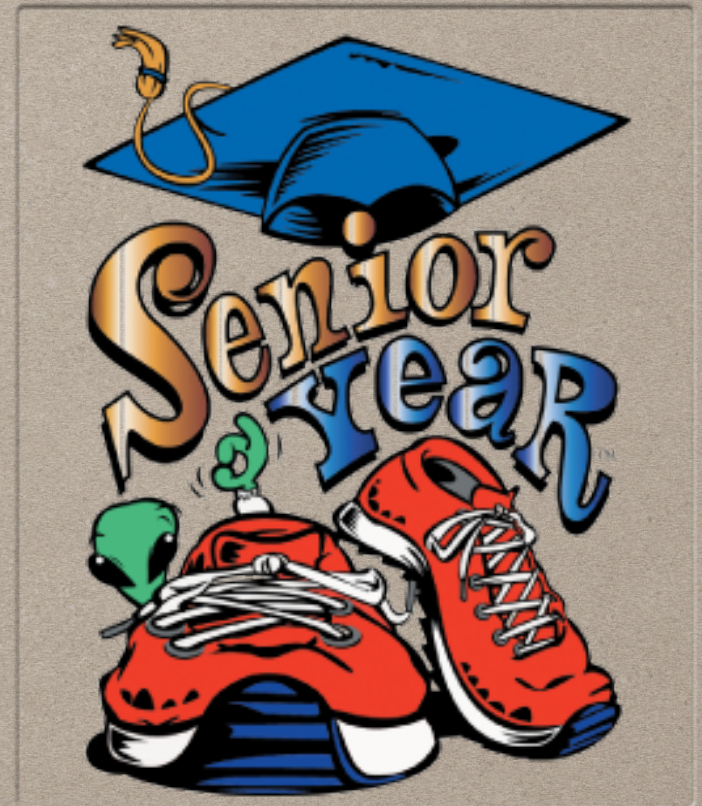
# 12TH GRADE

- **August:**
  - College Bootcamp at HHS: college application preparation and management
- **September:**
  - Back to school night (S1)
  - Sign up for college rep visitations (Naviance)
  - Review your academic records
  - Begin your scholarship search
- **October:**
  - Visit post-secondary schools and finalize your application list
  - New 2017-2018: students can file FAFSA form as early as October 1st (reporting 2015 income)
- **November:**
  - Check post-secondary school applications statuses
  - Goal: complete applications by Thanksgiving
- **December:**
  - Check your deadlines
  - Complete scholarship applications



# 12TH GRADE

- **January:**
  - Request mid-year reports if your college requires them (Naviance)
- **February:**
  - Back to school night (S2)
  - ASVAB sign-ups (Military)
  - Keep checking scholarships! New additions to the list weekly!
- **March:**
  - Review post-secondary options and financial aid packages
- **April:**
  - Register for AP exams
  - Be aware of tuition deposit deadlines
- **May:**
  - AP Exams
  - Complete Senior Exit Survey in Naviance (Graduation Project Task)
- **June:**
  - Graduation!
  - Notify post-secondary schools of any private scholarships or grants you will be receiving
