

THE HEMPFIELD REPORT CARD

The Hempfield High School report card provides feedback on student achievement, behaviors, and practices using a three-prong approach:

1. Academic Grade
2. Effort & Work Habits
3. Teacher Comments (coded and/or free form)

THE ACADEMIC GRADE

The academic grade is reflected using a letter designation, currently A–F with pluses and minuses in grades 9–12.

The final grades on a Hempfield High School transcript for each course are comprised of 70% summative assessment data and 30% formal (graded) formative assessment data.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Participation in extracurricular activities provides opportunities for students to explore areas of interest beyond the classroom. Students are able to develop leadership skills, express ideas, demonstrate responsibility, and learn to respect the rights of others while practicing self-discipline. During the 2016–2017 school year, more than 1,400 students participated in inter-scholastic athletics. Hempfield students compete in the Lancaster-Lebanon League. Seventy-one (71) teams provide opportunities for girls and boys to participate in baseball, basketball, bowling, cheerleading, cross country, field hockey, football, golf, lacrosse, soccer, softball, swimming, tennis, track, volleyball, and wrestling.

Twenty-five (25) service clubs meet to provide activities for over 900 students. This includes 250 students who participate in National Honor Society, National Art Honor Society, Student Council, Varsity Club, and class Steering Committees.

Additionally, 349 students are involved in band, orchestra, and choral groups. One musical and a dance theatre production, as well as the Student Council Variety Show offer enrichment in theatre arts for approximately 300 students.

HEMPFIELD SCHOOL DISTRICT

Hempfield High School is located in Landisville, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. The Hempfield School District, which adjoins the city of Lancaster, includes a large residential area, but continues to have fertile, well-kept farms. Hempfield High School serves a relatively large community of approximately 46,000 residents living in a 44-square mile area. Citizens reside in East Hempfield and West Hempfield Townships, and the boroughs of East Petersburg and Mountville, all of which comprise the Hempfield School District.
