**Obtaining BHRS "Wrap-Around" Services for your Child**

## **Step One**

Obtain Medical Assistance for your child (if you he/she does not already have it) by contacting the Department of Public Welfare at 717-299-7421.

Medical Assistance is the only insurance that covers Behavioral Health Rehabilitation Services (BHRS), commonly known as Wraparound. Once you have contacted the Department of Public Welfare, they will assist you with the application process. To obtain BHR services, your child must have an Axis I diagnosis such as: Autism, Pervasive Developmental Disorder (PDD), Attention Deficit Disorder (ADD), Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Depression, Oppositional Defiant Disorder, Reactive Attachment Disorder, Bipolar, or Intermittent Explosive Disorder. Although your family's income is not a determining eligibility factor, income must be reported within the Medical Assistance application. They may ask for your pay stubs for the past two weeks, documentation of diagnosis, and a picture ID of your child (i.e. passport, school ID, or library card). Please have these ready in order to expedite the process.

## **Step Two**

Make an appointment with a Core Provider.

As soon as you receive your child's Medical Assistance card, contact [PerformCare](#) at 1-888-700-7370 (this is the Managed Care Organization (MCO) for Lancaster County) and they will refer you to a provider for an evaluation. You may also contact any of the agencies directed listed on the reverse side of this page.

### **What are BHRS “Wrap-Around” Services?**

**Behavioral Health Rehabilitation Services (BHRS)** Process designed to support students with severe mental health needs. The BHRS process depends on a team of individuals, including the student, parents, educators, and mental health professionals in order to create and carry out an individualized treatment plan in a variety of settings.

**Therapeutic Support Staff (TSS)** Provides individualized mental health programs to students in community--based settings, including home, school, community center, faith organizations, neighborhood or extended family.

**Mobile Therapist (MT)** Provides individual and family psychotherapy in the home environment to identify healthy adaptive skills that students can use.

**Behavior Specialist Consultant (BSC)** Writes and monitors behavior treatment plans for students who have been diagnosed with behavioral and mental health disorders.
