- **-Falcon Garden** (Christine Baker): We bought new pots for the front of the school and have some nice flowers in them for the Fall season. The flowers in the Falcon Garden are also looking really good. I would love to get a list of volunteers to help with weeding. Hope to schedule that soon.

-Family Engagement Committee (Lindsay Gregg): This is a new committee this year. The goal of this committee is to engage new families coming to Farmdale, all throughout the year. The new students will receive a "Farmdale welcome bag" from the FPA that will have a Farmdale shirt (same as the DASH shirts) and a few other Farmdale things. We will also provide the family with more info about the FPA, how they can get involved and they will have the opportunity to be paired with a "seasoned" Farmdale family to help them integrate into the school community. - **-Family Movie Night** (Lindsay Gregg): 9/15 Movie will start at Dusk. Families can begin to arrive around 6:30pm. Food from food trucks will be available for purchase. Cotton Candy, Popcorn and Water will be free. The movie that was selected was Elemental.
- -Falcon Dash (Melissa Reihart): The dash kicked off last Thursday. We have six shirt sponsors this year, with two new businesses included. We have earned \$10,322 so far, with our goal being \$25,000. Additional prizes will be added over the next three weeks. Due to the Hempfield Barnstormers night, prize bags will be distributed on Monday instead of Friday this week. A parent expressed their concern in regards to the online fees. At the request of participating schools, Get Movin' added an option to allow sponsors to pay the processing fee so that schools would receive more money. This is a strictly voluntary process. Last year, we were able to keep 97% of our online donations thanks to the generosity of our donors. Ensuring the safety of our family's financial information is very important and this company is able to provide that security. Please feel free to talk to Melissa Reihart, if you have any additional questions. We have roughly 14-16 volunteers currently to help on Dash day. Due to the Dash being so early in the year, it is hard for us to utilize the volunteer sign ups from the FPA packets. We will do our best contacting volunteers once we receive the list.
