Changes/Highlights/Benefits

- Flex is moved to the end of the day.
 - Allows all teachers to have flex at the same time.
 - Students will have access to all of their teachers, not just core teachers.
 - Allows all students to have flex at the same time.
 - Opens the possibilities for club meetings.
 - Less loss of instructional time for extra curricular early dismissals
 - Less loss of instructional minutes on alternate schedule days (No Flex)
- WHHS is moved to Period 4
 - Eliminates conflicts with music programs.



Changes/Highlights/Benefits

- Lunches will be mixed grade level.
- Enable us to have 4 lunches of ~450 students
 - Eliminates current disparity between lunches
 - Currently lunches range from 600 – 100 students
 - Less crowding, safer, more efficient
- Provides greater scheduling flexibility
 - Eliminates periods that only certain classes can run.



Changes/Highlights/Benefits

- Instead of one long break in the middle of the day, students will now have two breaks spread throughout the school day.
- Reduces the amount of flex time throughout the building.
 - We currently have Flex time in the building from 10:35 – 1:25. This is roughly 3 hours during which a portion of our students are not taking a class.
 - Reducing this amount of flex time through out the building will help us run our building more efficiently.



Schedule Concerns

- Social and emotional
 - Loss of downtime with grade level friends
 - We retain FLEX time. Most students will still have a grade level flex with one of their core area teachers.
 - Difference in interests between grade levels
 - We hope to capitalize on the ability of our upper-class persons to help our less experienced students understand what HHS has to offer
 - Lunch break splitting class
 - (60 min of uninterrupted class + 30 minutes of class)
 - We have seen great success with classes taking breaks which has helped with social and emotional health



What's NOT changing

- The school day is not changing
- Students still have 4 classes/day
- Students still have 42 minutes of flex
- Students still have a 30-minute lunch
- Students still have 5-minutes between periods
