Families must pay a yearly usage fee to cover the cost of maintenance and repair resulting from regular use. This completed form and/or payment should be returned in the envelope provided.

In addition, the student and parent must understand and agree to the following:

- The student must be responsible and take proper care of the instrument and will return the instrument in the same condition other than what is considered normal wear.
- Any damage or loss caused by misuse, abuse, or negligence on the part of the student will be the responsibility of the student and/or parent/guardian.
- The student and/or parent/guardian will not attempt any repairs but will bring any damage to the attention of the music instructor.
- There will be no refunds issued if the student decides to discontinue lessons or drops band/orchestra before the end of the school year.
