

Hempfield School District Georgelis Law Firm Stadium Turf and Track Rules

To insure proper care of the turf and track surfaces:

1. Absolutely no food, gum, seeds, or tobacco products are permitted. Water is the only beverage permitted.
2. Turf shoes, molded cleats, and rubber-soled athletic shoes are permitted. No metal spikes. No high-heeled shoes.
3. Unless the track surface is covered, no spikes or cleats of any kind are permitted on the track surface with the exception of approved track and field spikes.
4. Vehicles that are permitted include golf carts, small utility vehicles (i.e. John Deere Gator), and lawn tractors. All other vehicles are prohibited. Carts pulled by approved vehicles must have pneumatic tires.
5. Tents must be free standing structures. No stakes may be used to support any type of tent for structure.
6. Metal chair legs must be protected by rubber end tips and cannot contain any jagged edges that may damage the surfaces. Team benches should have the rubber ends on the tubing to avoid damaging the surface.
7. Benches, goals, and equipment should never be drug across the surfaces.
8. No bicycles, roller blades, and skate boards are permitted.
9. No animals of any kind are permitted.
10. After use, goals and equipment are to be removed and stored in appropriate area of the stadium.

We all need to work together to maintain and care for the track and field surfaces in the Georgelis Law Firm Stadium. Please adhere to the above rules and assist by cleaning-up all debris when leaving the event. Dispose of trash in receptacles provided.
