INVITATION TO BID

Hempfield School District, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania will receive bids for Underground Fuel Tank System Removal at Landisville Primary Center and Landisville Middle School. Bids will be accepted until February 1, 2024, at 1:30 PM, prevailing time.

Bids shall be submitted in triplicate in a sealed envelope marked "Underground Fuel Tank System Removal at Landisville Primary Center and Landisville Middle School" and delivered to the Hempfield School District Administration Office at 200 Church S., Landisville PA 17538.

The bid opening will take place on **February 1, 2024,** at 1:30 PM at the District Administration Office located at 200 Church S., Landisville PA 17538. The bids will be publicly read.

Each bid must be accompanied by **bid security** in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond of a surety company legally authorized to do business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in an amount **equal to ten (10%) of the bid**.

No bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of the actual opening of bids.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for satisfactory performance and payment bond or bonds in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price within ten (10) days after the Contract has been awarded and may also be required to furnish a Contractor's Qualification Statement.

Hempfield School District reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to accept or reject any parts thereof, or items therein, and to waive any defects or irregularities in bids and bid securities, and to make the award that is determined to be in the best interest of the Hempfield School District.

Electronic Bidding Documents may be secured by bona-fide bidders on or after January 10, 2024. All Bidders are required to obtain Bid Documents through Moore Engineering Company, or their bids may be rejected. Bidders shall send a request to Moore Engineering Company, 3637 Columbia Avenue, Lancaster, PA 17603. Once the request and fee are received, the electronic Bid Documents will be forwarded via email.

The project is subject to the provisions of the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act, P.L. 744 and the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Acts.

Bidders shall refer to the provisions of Federal and State Statutes, Rules and Regulations dealing with the prevention of environmental pollution and the preservation of public, natural resources that affect the project, said provisions being submitted as part of the Specifications pursuant to Act No. 247 of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania approved October 26, 1972.
