

Dear Parent or Guardian:

We are pleased to inform you that Centerville Middle, East Petersburg, Farmdale, Mountville, & Rohrerstown will be implementing a new provision known as the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) in the 2023-2024 school year.

All enrolled students of Centerville Middle, East Petersburg, Farmdale, Mountville, & Rohrerstown are eligible to receive a nutritional breakfast and lunch each school day at **no charge** to your household. If you have students in buildings **not** listed above in your household; free or reduced meal eligibility will have to be performed through Direct Certification (SNAP, TANF, Medical Assistance) or income-based free or reduced application.

No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) at CMS, EPES, FES, MES, & RES will be able to participate in these meal programs without paying a fee or submitting an application.
